

PRACTICE:

Set up DAILY practice time which the entire family will respect. It is usually best if this is a regular time each day when there is a minimum of interruptions. Feel free to demand phones during this time.

LESSON TIME:

Please be on time for your lesson. Due to a heavy schedule, I will not be able to give a late student extra time. You owe it to yourself to receive the benefit of your full lesson time.

REGISTRATION:

\$20.00 yearly fee.

TUITION:

Pays for a student's study from Sept through June. It also includes Fees for recitals, for music workshops, piano parties, and sheet music. **For the past few years, I've absorbed these fees.**

I average bill...you will be charged 10 equal payments during the school year (33 lessons). Tuition is payable yearly, or monthly **in advance**.

45 min. lessons: \$163.00

1- hour lessons: \$216.00

You are expected to attend every lesson.

Don't cancel a lesson because you feel you are not prepared. Your lesson time can still be worthwhile as I have other activities that we can do.

THERE WILL BE NO MAKE-UP LESSONS for any reason. You may switch lesson time with another student.

Please remember — tuition is buying my time — IT IS RESERVED FOR YOU. If unused, it is of no value to anyone else.

THERE WILL BE NO DEDUCTION OR CREDIT FOR MISSED LESSONS.

I will arrange to make up any lessons that I must cancel.

PERFORMANCE:

There are **five mandatory** performance opportunities per year.

1. **WINTER RECITAL:** Students perform for family and swap **\$5.00** gifts. (The \$10.00 fee is included in tuition.)
2. **SPRING RECITAL:** a more formal recital is held the second Sunday in June. The students receive awards they have earned. (The \$10.00 fee is included in tuition.)
3. **WORKSHOPS:** 2 per school year. These informal gatherings are held on Sat. afternoons at **1:30 p.m.** They last about 1 hour.
4. **NATIONAL PIANO GUILD AUDITIONS:** These are optional professionally judged individual performance sessions, usually held in May. Each student will be individually prepared. The fee varies by category.
5. **MTNA/GRANITE STATE/MVPTA** competition/ recitals/master-class some may be virtual 😞
(Fees are not included in tuition.)

INTEREST:

Your display of interest in each lesson and each new assignment is important! Encourage your child to participate and to perform at home for family and friends. When he does so, be generous in expressing your appreciation and pleasure in his performance.

WAITING ROOM:

Parents, siblings, and friends (limit 4) are welcome to wait during lessons in the studio waiting room. Music education works best in an atmosphere free of distraction. Special consideration may be made for children less than 9 years of age or for students with disabilities.

LENDING LIBRARY:

An extensive book, video, music score, CD and cassette library is available for your use. All items must be **signed out** and returned in two weeks.
